Subject: Bay View Contract

On Wednesday, November 19, 2014, Kensington Police Protection & Community Services District Board President Len Welsh and Bay View Refuse & Recycling owner Lewis Figone signed the eight- year franchise agreement between the District and Bay View Refuse & Recycling that was approved by the KPPCSD Board of Directors at their November 13th meeting.

The \$10 million dollar contract will begin on September 1, 2015, and run through August 31, 2023. The contract was negotiated over several months between District representatives KPPCSD Board President Len Welsh, KPPCSD Vice President Linda Lipscomb, KPPCSD General Manager/ Chief of Police Greg Harman, and HF&H Consultant Tracy Swanborn, and Bay View representatives Greg Christie, Bay View Counsel Haig Harris, and Bay View CPA Charles Cowden.

The sole source negotiations saved the District approximately \$78,000 in costs that would have been expensed if the District had used a request for proposal (RFP) process.

A recent customer survey documented that 95% of Kensington residents were satisfied with the service provided by Bay View and that over 70% were satisfied with the cost of that service.
