## NEWS RELEASE

### District Website

On 1/14/2015, Interim Chief of Police Kevin Hart received an email from a concerned resident regarding a possible security breach of the [www.kensingtoncalifornia.org](http://www.kensingtoncalifornia.org) website. Based on the efforts of KPD staff and our webmaster, we have determined that no security breach occurred. We performed system diagnostics on the website and found no traces of viruses or malware.

The resident advised in his email that while clicking on a link on the KPPCSD website, his McAfee WebAdvisor alerted him of a suspicious page. Based on the screenshot of the WebAdvisor alert, it appears that the resident's browser was attempting to redirect him to a page on the [www.fastnclick.com](http://www.fastnclick.com).

Internal searches on the website found no malicious software present. External searches of the website using Quttera and Securi found no presence of malware or viruses.

We recontacted the resident who originally reported this issue and determined that he was unable to replicate the redirect from his computer.

Based on the results of our efforts in investigating this matter, we are confident that no security breach occurred within the district website. Additionally, we have been utilizing SSL security for several years now on any pages within the district website where residents may enter personal information.
